Choose lots of scrappy fabrics:

(I chose primarily Kim Diehl fabrics – hence, the quilt's name!)

Variety of **Background** fabrics 13 colorful **Prints** (if you want them all to be different)

***Measurements for SMALL quilt; LARGE in (parentheses)

Cut from the Background fabrics:

Four 3" (4") squares – cut in half diagonally to make 8 triangles *You will only use 4 of the resulting triangles; save the rest for later Eight 1-1/2" (2") squares

Cut from Prints:

One 2-1/2" (3-1/2") square (center square so choose a favorite!)
Choose Four of your leftover triangles from the 3" (4") squares from Block #1
Eight 1-1/2" (2") squares



1. **Corner HST's.** Pair four 3" (4") **Print** triangles with four 3" (4") Background triangles together to make 4 HST units. Square each unit to 2-1/2" (3-1/2").





2. **4-Patches.** Using the 1-1/2" (2") squares, make four sets of 4-patches in the alignment shown below (print placed in lower left and upper right positions). Units should measure 2-1/2" (3-1/2").



3. With your 2-1/2" (3-1/2") square in the center, arrange and stitch all units together according to the **Block** picture (upper right). Block should measure 6-1/2" (9-1/2").

Seams ¼" unless noted otherwise Always press toward the print fabric unless otherwise noted HST = Half-square Triangle RST = Right sides together
