## Choose lots of scrappy fabrics

(I chose primarily Kim Diehl fabrics - hence, the quilt's name!)
Variety of Background fabrics
13 colorful Prints (if you want them all to be different)
***Measurements for SMALL quilt; LARGE in (parentheses)

## Cut from the Background fabrics:

Four 3" (4") squares - cut in half diagonally to make 8 triangles
*You will only use 4 of the resulting triangles; save the rest for later
Eight 1-1/2" (2") squares


## Cut from Prints:

One 2-1/2" (3-1/2") square (center square so choose a favorite!)
Choose Four of your leftover triangles from the $3^{\prime \prime}\left(4^{\prime \prime}\right)$ squares from Block \#1
Eight 1-1/2" (2") squares

## Unit Assembly:

1. Corner HST's. Pair four 3" (4") Print triangles with four $3^{\prime \prime}\left(4^{\prime \prime}\right)$ Background triangles together to make 4 HST units. Square each unit to $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\left(3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$.

2. 4-Patches. Using the $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\left(2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ squares, make four sets of 4-patches in the alignment shown below (print placed in lower left and upper right positions). Units should measure 2-1/2" (3-1/2").

3. With your 2-1/2" (3-1/2") square in the center, arrange and stitch all units together according to the Block picture (upper right). Block should measure 6-1/2" (9-1/2").

## Seams $1 / 4$ " unless noted otherwise

Always press toward the print fabric unless otherwise noted
HST = Half-square Triangle
RST = Right sides together
