***Measurements for SMALL quilt; LARGE in (parentheses)

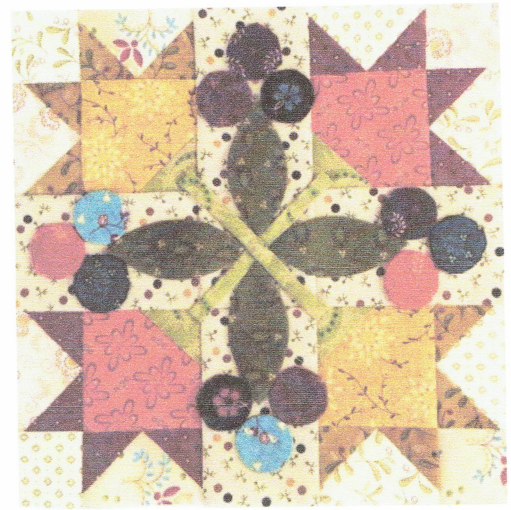
Cut from Background fabrics:

- [A] Four – 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" (3-1/2" x 5") rectangles
- [B] One – 2-1/2" (3-1/2") square
- [C] Eight – 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" (2" x 3-1/2") rectangles (flying geese bodies)
- [D] Four – 1-1/2" (2") squares

Cut from Prints:

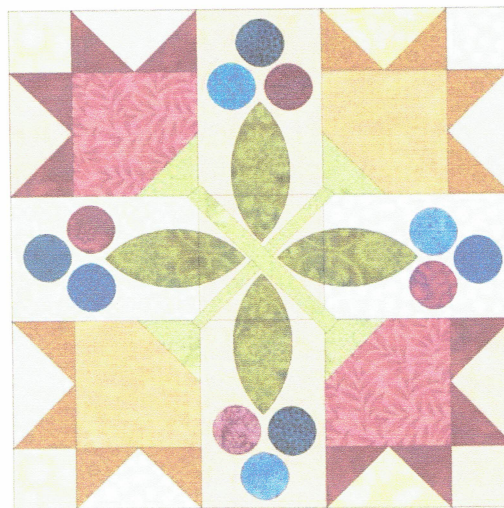
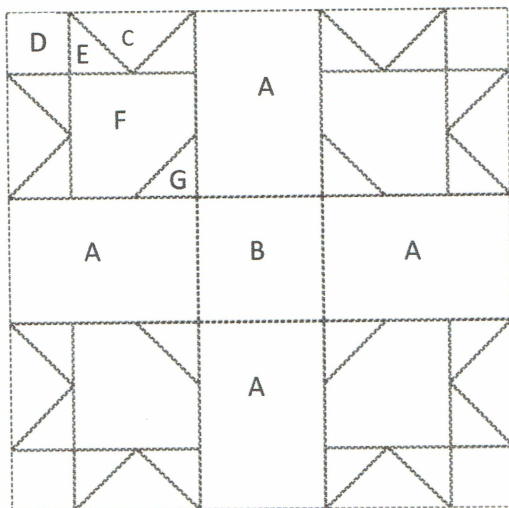
- [E] Sixteen – 1-1/2" (2") squares (flying geese wings)
- [F] Four – 2-1/2" (3-1/2") squares
- [G] Four – 1-1/2" (2") squares (light green for flower stem)

Applique: 4 petals – dark green; 2 stems – light green; 12 circles (template page attached)



Unit Assembly:

1. **Center Flowers.** Draw diagonal line across the four green **G** Print squares. Pin to one corner of each of the four **F** Print squares, RST, and stitch along the line. Press toward the corner and trim excess from the back – be careful not to cut off your green triangle corner! Unit should measure 2-1/2" (3-1/2") square.
2. **Flying Geese.** Make 8 Flying Geese units from the eight **C** Background rectangles and sixteen **E** Print squares. Refer to attached instructions for **Making Flying Geese** if needed.
3. Stitch all units and pieces together as shown below left. Unfinished block should measure 8-1/2" (12-1/2").



4. Prepare and apply applique using your favorite method. Use the above right picture for placement. *Note: You may need to shorten or lengthen your stems to fit the way you like.*

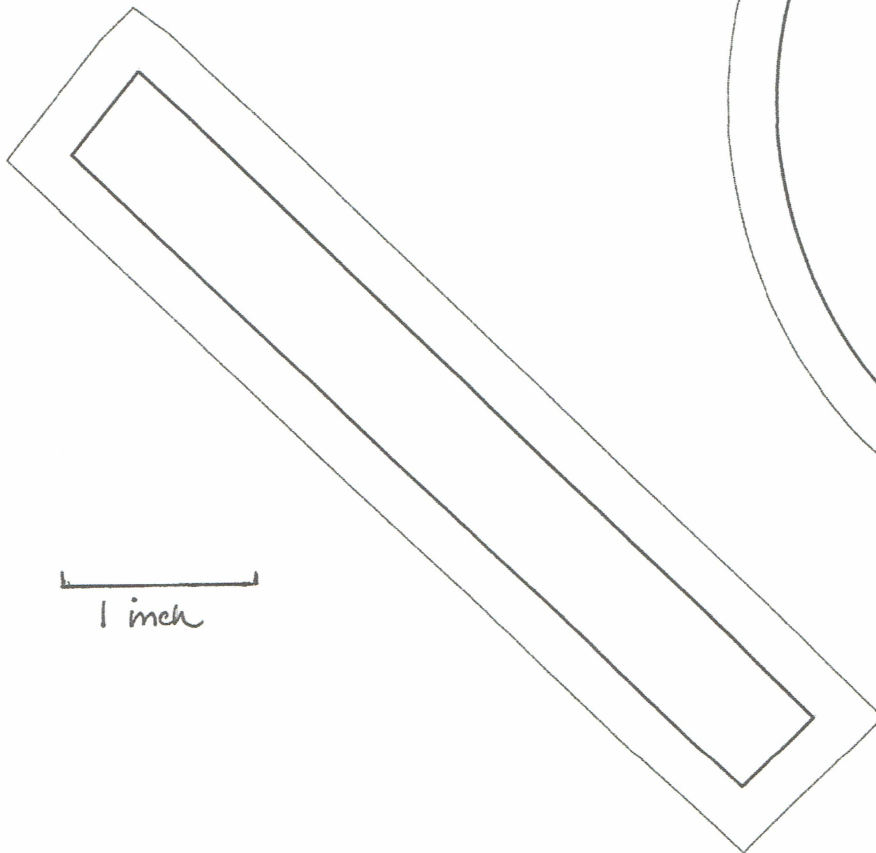
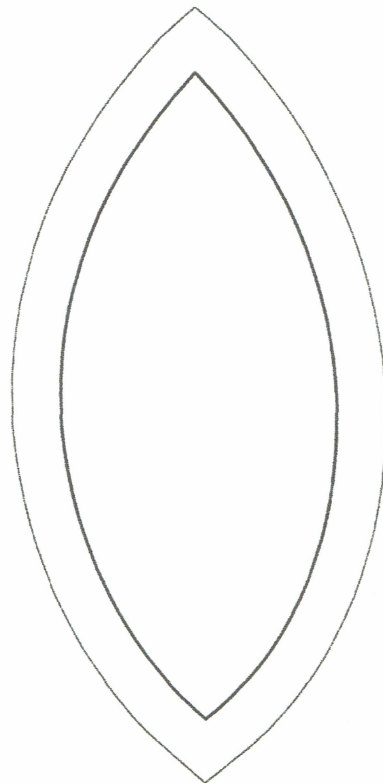
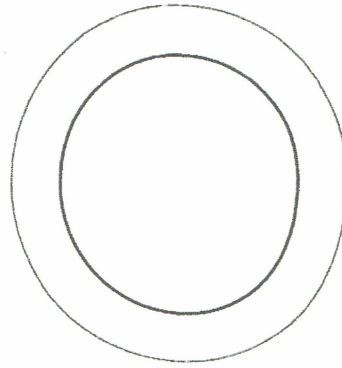
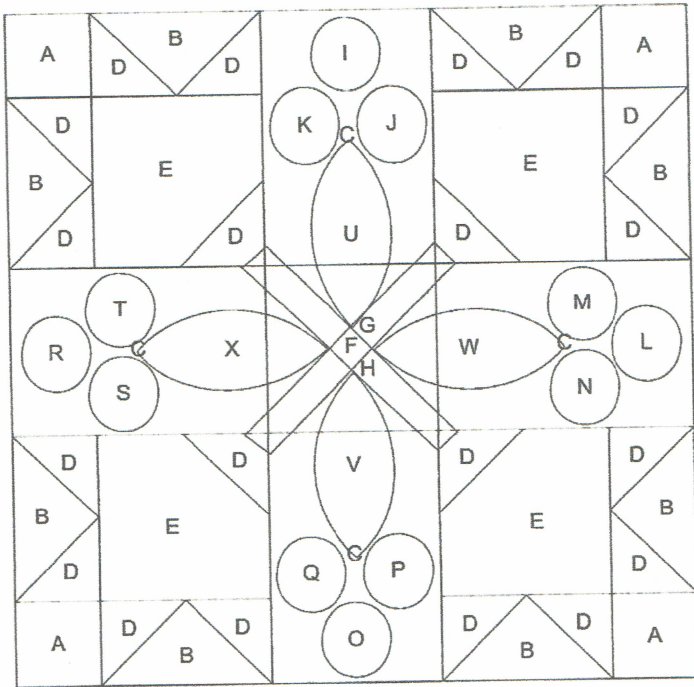

RST = Right sides together

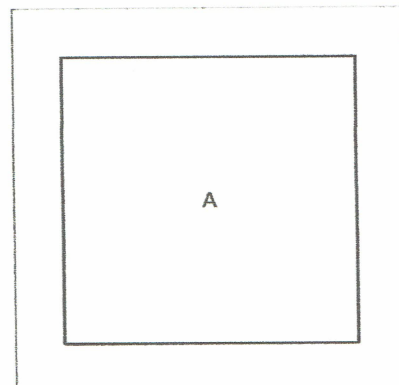
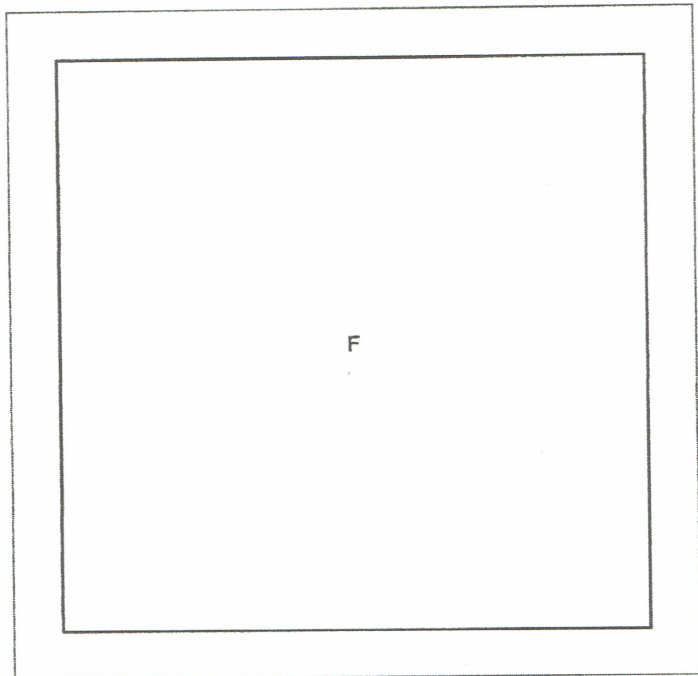
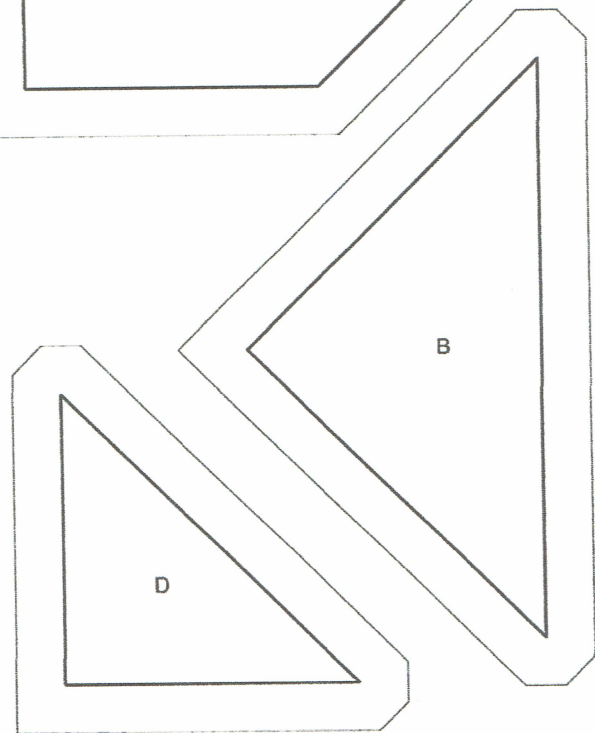
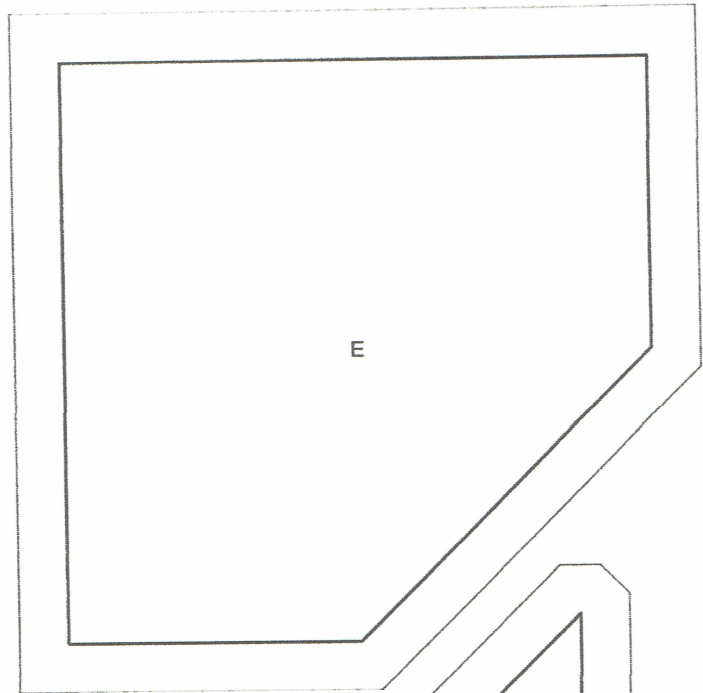
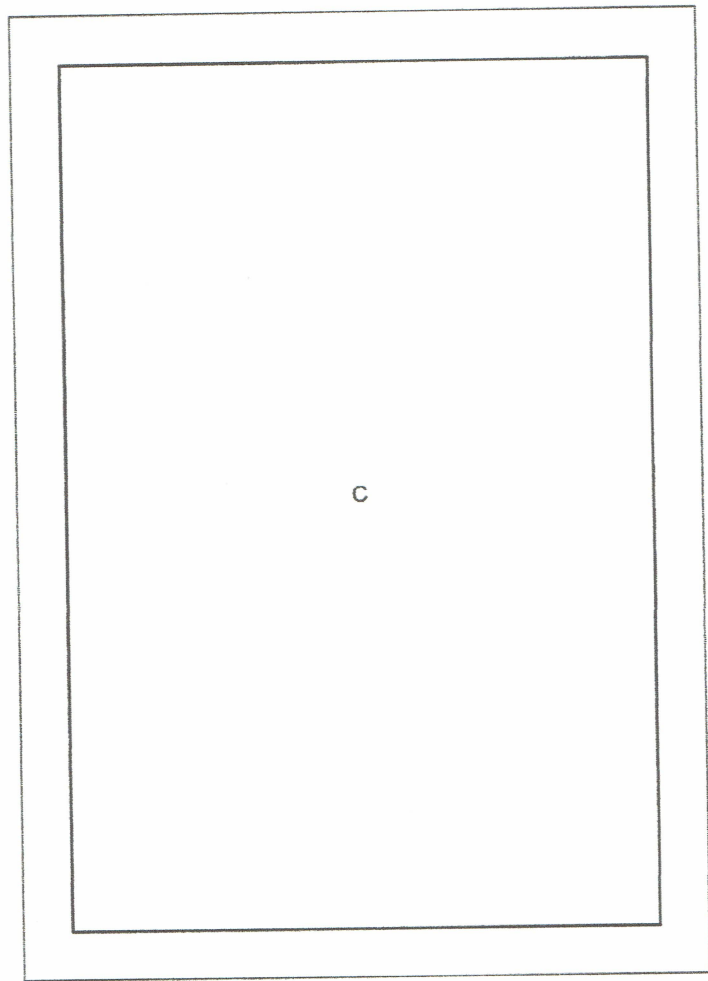

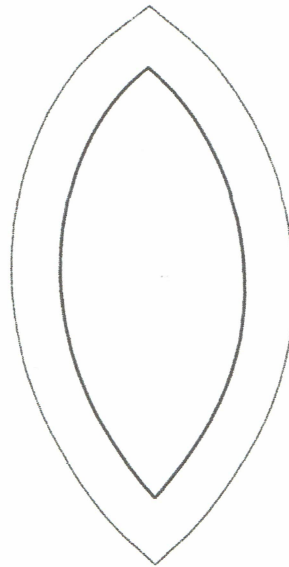
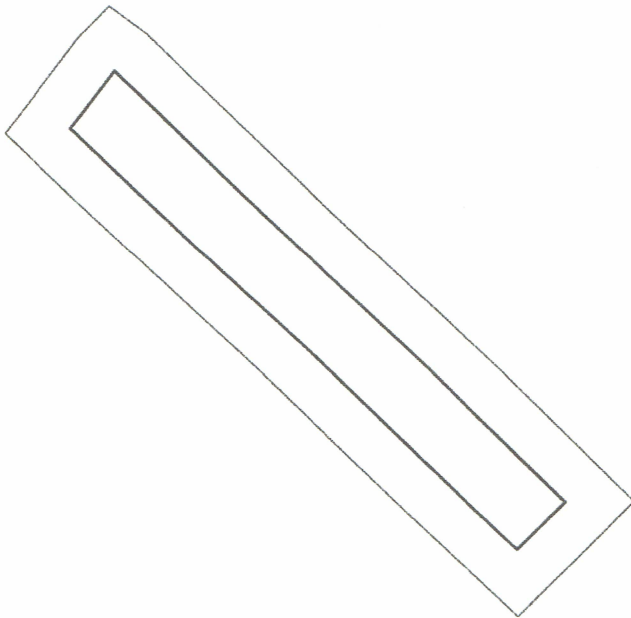
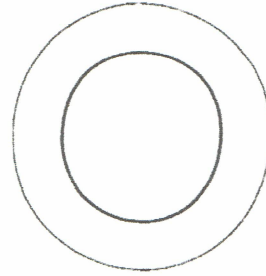
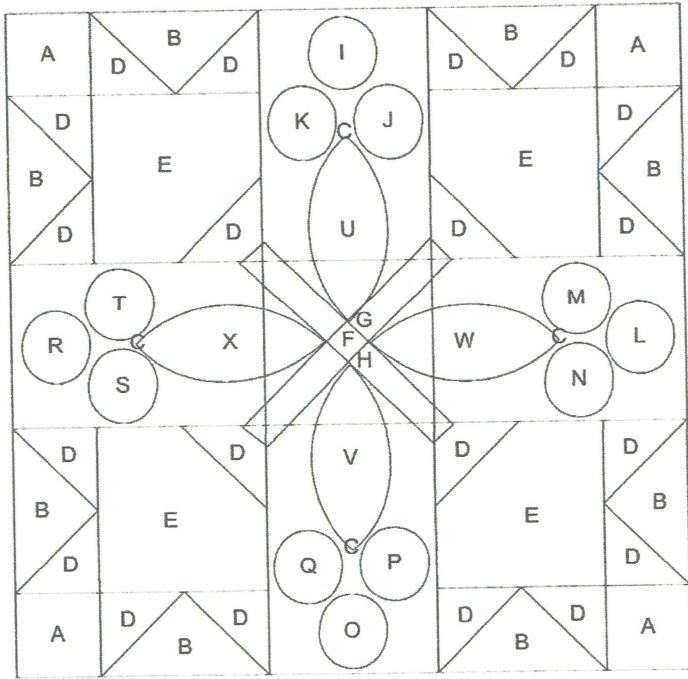
Block #4 Large
