You will make 3 of these blocks. For EACH block cut:
Cut from Prints:
Four 1-1/2" (2") squares from the same fabric (Center)
Eight 1-1/2" (2") squares from a variety of fabrics
Cut from Backgrounds:
Four 1" (1-1/2") squares from the same fabric (Center)
Four 1-1/2" (2") squares from a variety of fabrics
Four 1-1/2" $\times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\left(2^{\prime \prime} \times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ rectangles from a variety of fabrics


## Unit Assembly:

1. Center Modified Snowballs. Draw a diagonal line on the back of each $1^{\prime \prime}\left(1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ Background square from the same fabric. Place one the corner of each 1-1/2" (2") Print square from the same fabric, RST. Stitch on the drawn diagonal line. Trim and press seam toward the Print. Square to $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\left(2^{\prime \prime}\right)$. You should have 4 of each fabric.

2. Flying Geese. Make 4 Flying Geese units from the $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\left(2^{\prime \prime} \times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ Background rectangles and the $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ $\left(2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ Print squares cut from a variety of fabrics. Refer to attached instructions for Making Flying Geese.
3. Arrange and stitch all units together according to the Block picture. Unfinished block should measure 4-1/2" (6-1/2").
4. Make 3 of these blocks using a different fabric in each block's Center Modified Snowballs unit.
