

COOL DIEHL – Blocks #9

*****Measurements for SMALL quilt; LARGE in (parentheses)**

You will make 2 of these blocks, with a different main color in each block. For EACH block cut:

Cut from Prints:

One 1-1/2" (2") RED square

Two 2" (2-1/2") squares from one print

Four 1"x1-1/2" (1-1/4"x2") rectangles from the same print

Cut from Backgrounds:

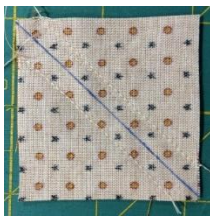
Two 2" (2-1/2") squares from a variety of fabrics

Four 1"x1-1/2" (1-1/4"x2") rectangles from a variety of fabrics



Block Assembly:

1. **Corner Half Square Triangles.** Draw a diagonal line on the back of each 2" (2-1/2") **Background** square. Pair these with the 2" (2-1/2") **Print** squares, RST. Stitch 1/4" on each side of the drawn diagonal line. Cut on the drawn line to make 4 HST units. Square to 1-1/2" (2").



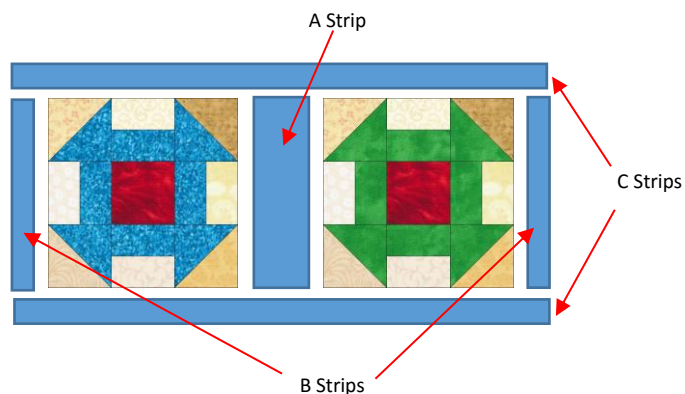
2. **Assemble Churn Dash.** Arrange and stitch all pieces together according to the **Block** picture above. Block should measure 3-1/2" (5"). Make 2 of these blocks, using 2 different main colors.

Sash/Border Blocks: From the Background fabrics, cut:

- 1 A strip – 1-1/2"x3-1/2" (2"x5")
- 2 B strips – 1"x3-1/2" (1-1/4"x5")
- 2 C strips – 1"x8-1/2" (1-1/4"x12-1/2")

Following the diagram below, sew the strips to the blocks to complete your unit.

Complete unit should measure 4-1/2"x8-1/2" (6-1/2"x12-1/2")



Seams 1/4" unless noted otherwise

HST = Half-square Triangle

RST = Right sides together
