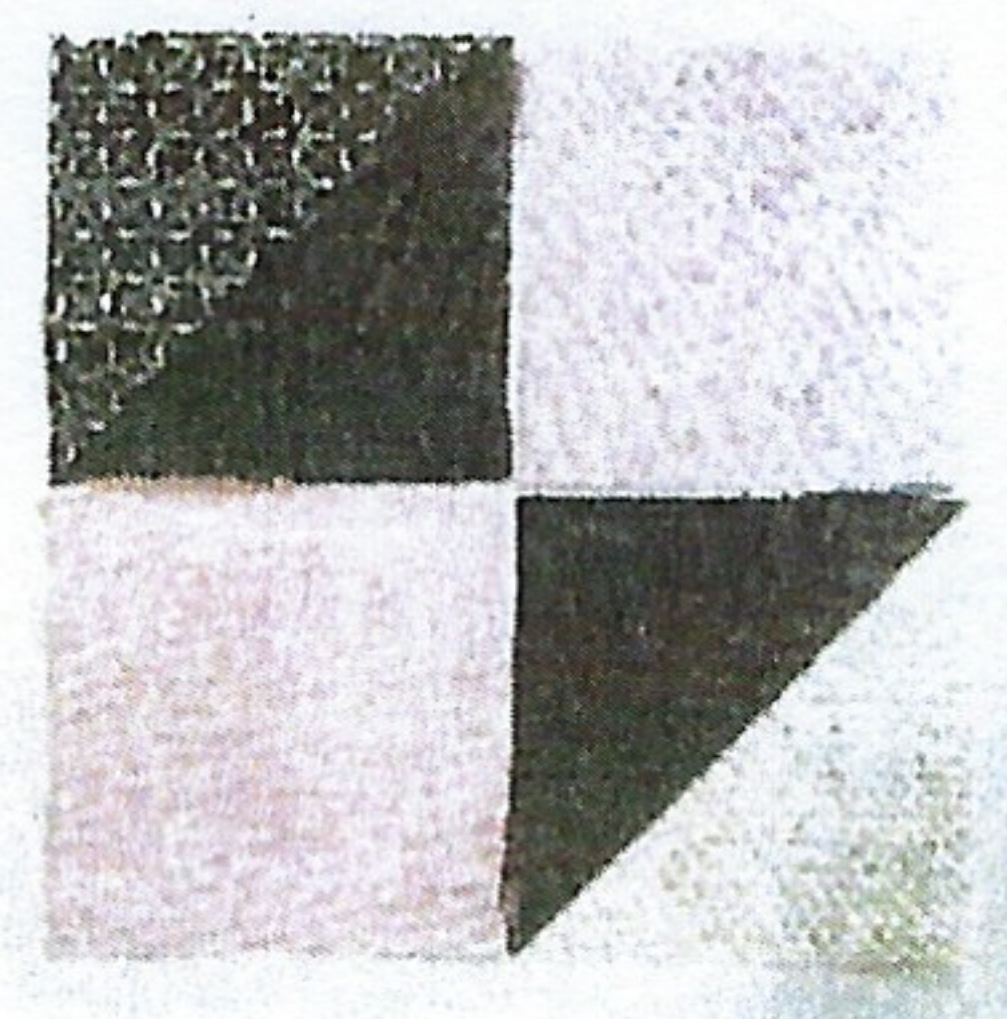


From here we will sew $1/4$ " from the line on both sides of the line, followed by cutting on the line. IF you want to cut your squares on ONE diagonal before sewing, this is fine as well. you will actually sew each HST together this way. HOWEVER, if you are cutting first, you will be sewing on the bias and could stretch your seam if you're not careful.



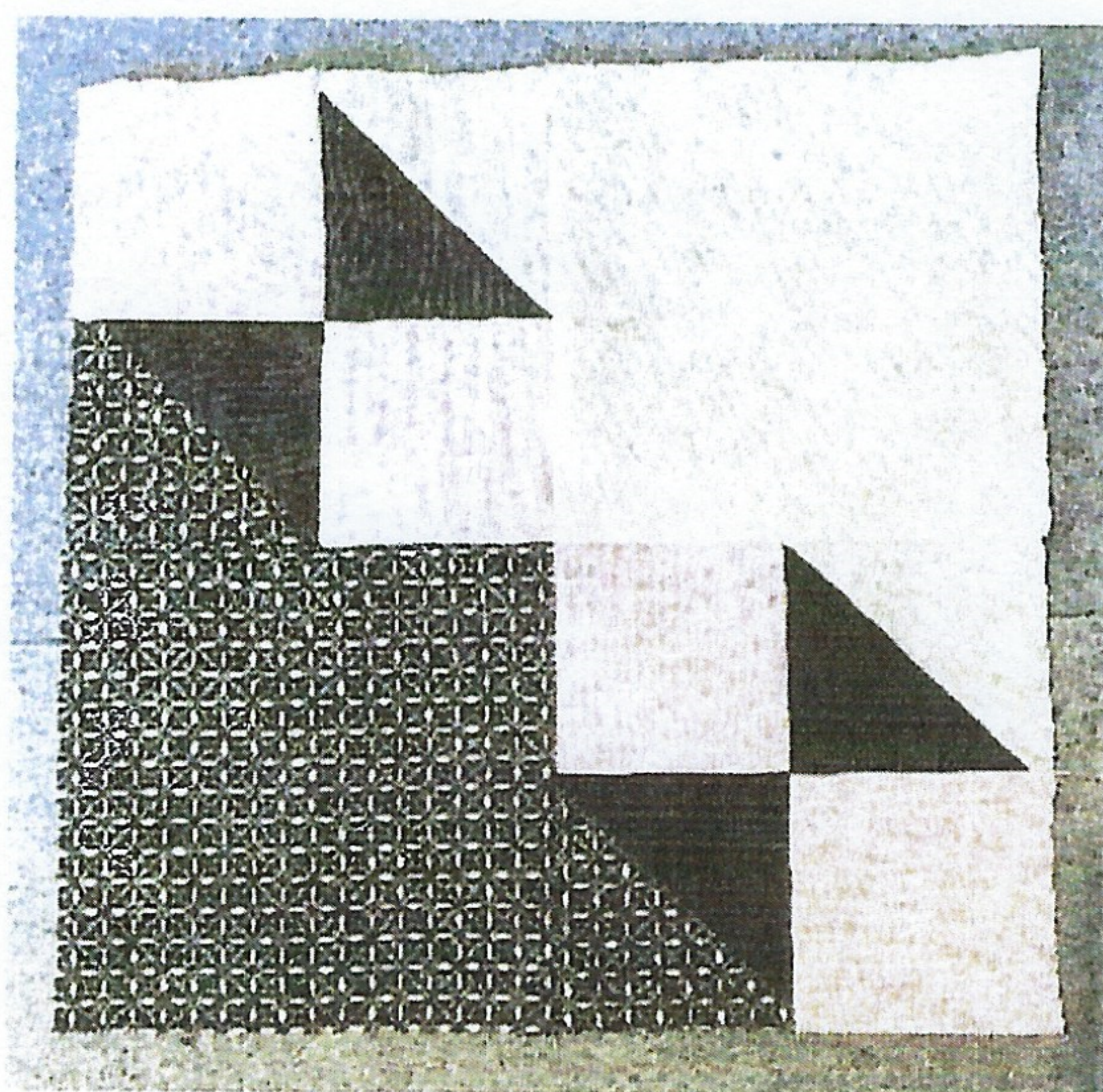
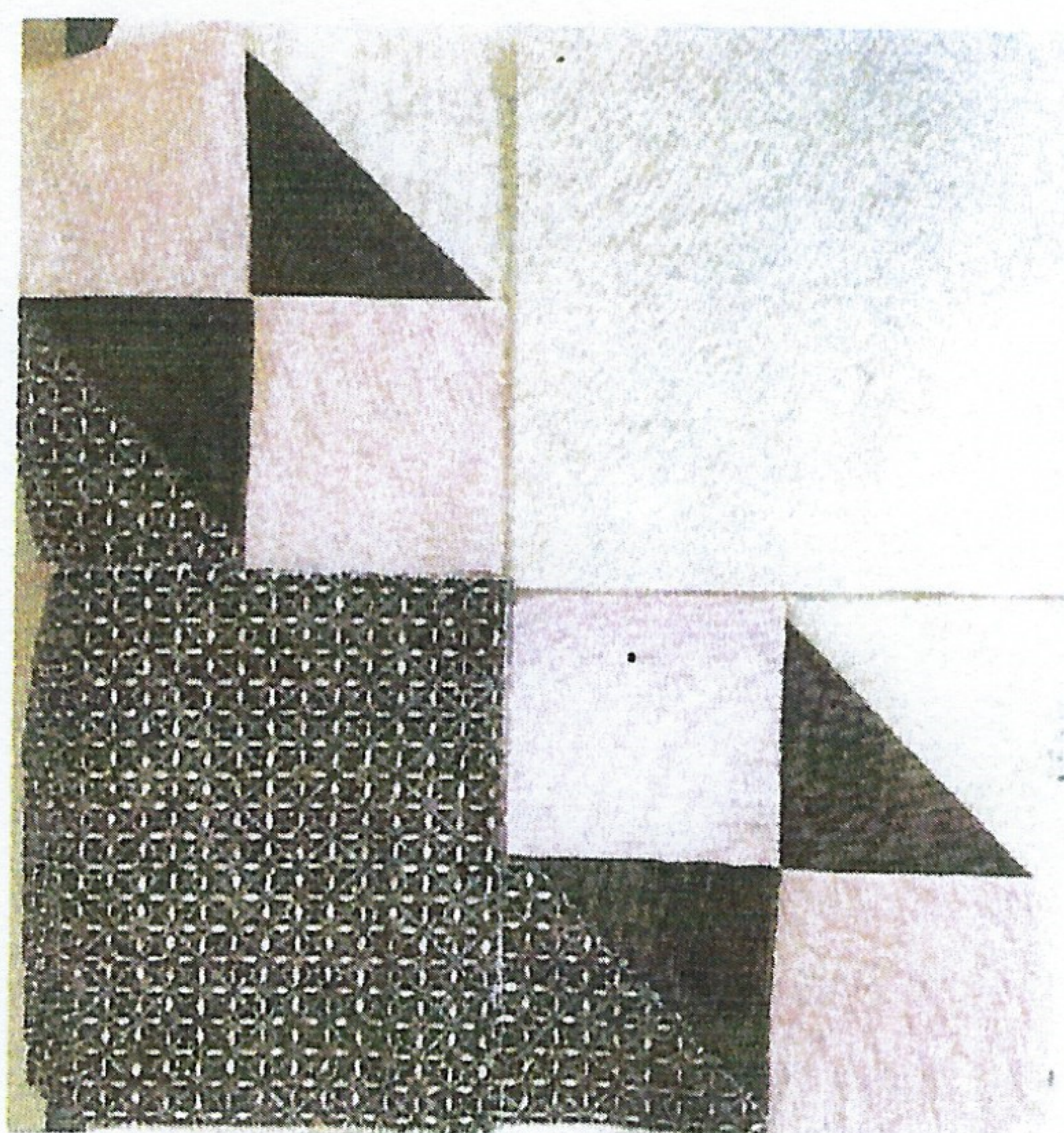
We will trim these HSTs down to $3-1/2$ ". I pressed toward the darker fabric in each set.

Now grab those $3-1/2$ " MEDIUM 1 squares we will assemble some larger units for our next step in this clue. We will use these and the HSTs we completed above.



Here are the deconstructed units, these should measure $6-1/2$ " after pressing and trimming.

Our final step will be to grab those $6-1/2$ " squares to finish our $12-1/2$ " units for today. Our deconstructed and finished blocks can be pressed in your favourite way. I chose to pinwheel my seams.



My easiest mistake was to sew the four patches with the smaller four patches rotated. Please make sure your LIGHT touches LIGHT and your MEDIUM 2 touches MEDIUM 2. With the smaller 4-patch units, please make sure your DARKS point toward each other.

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
