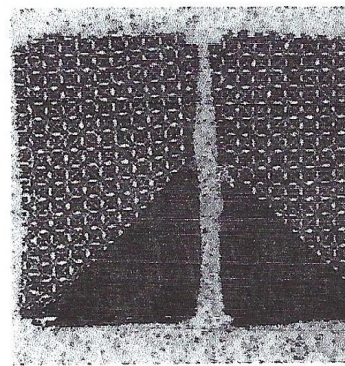


Let's jump right in, cutting first:

LIGHT		All Sizes
7-1/4" WOF strip		1
Sub-cut to 7-1/4" square		1
MEDIUM 1		All Sizes
6-1/2" WOF strip		1
Sub-cut to 6-1/2" squares		4
AND		
3-1/2" squares		8
MEDIUM 2		All Sizes
3-1/2" WOF strips		3-4
Sub-cut to 3-1/2" squares		8
AND 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles		8
AND 3-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles		4
DARK		All Sizes
3-7/8" WOF strips		1
Sub-cut to 3-7/8" squares		4
Trim the leftover to 3-1/2"		Scraps plus 1 WOF
Sub-cut to 3-1/2" squares		8

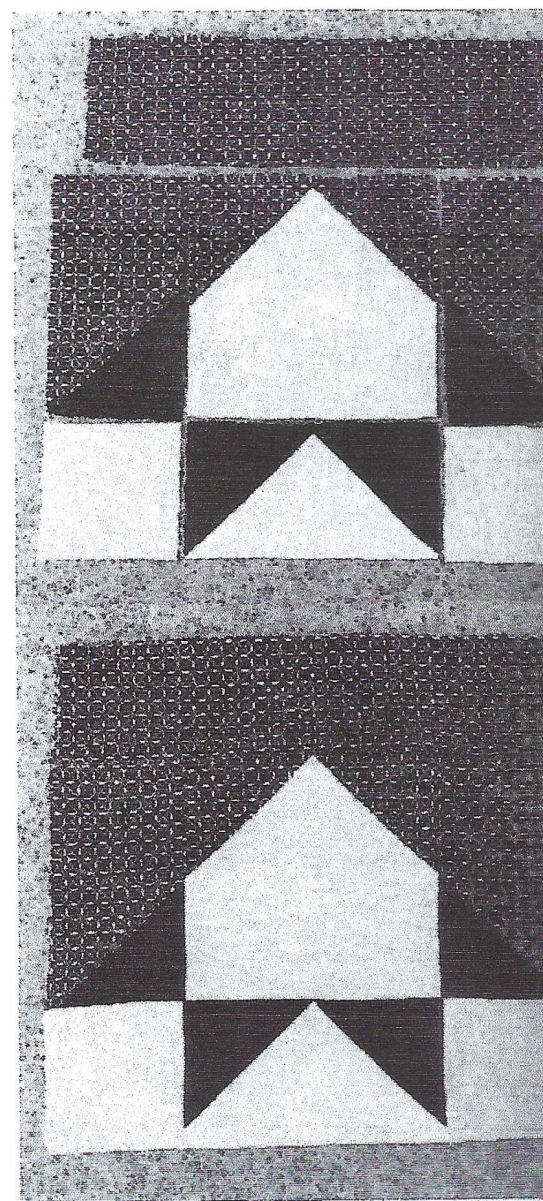
Let's use our 7-1/4" squares to make some flying geese using the no waste method. We need to trim these down to 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" for now and we will have four of them.

Grabbing the MEDIUM 2 6-1/2" rectangles and the DARK 3-1/2" squares, we will use these using the stitch and flip method. We need four on the left and four on the right.



Using our MEDIUM 1) 6-1/2" squares and MEDIUM 2) 3-1/2" squares, we will create a "house" looking block with those smaller squares on adjacent corners, like a square in a square except only on two joining sides.

Here are our deconstructed units, you will see each of the parts assembled here.



Our units today should measure 12-1/2" and we need four of these.

Just a bit more cutting and we are done for now!

Let's finish off by cutting some units to set aside for later:

LIGHT		Queen and King ONLY			
12-1/2" WOF strips		1			
Sub-cut to 12-1/2" squares		2			
MEDIUM 2	Lap	Twin	Queen	King	
18-1/4" WOF strips	1	2	2	3	
Sub-cut to 18-1/2" squares	2	3	4	5	
Cut these on BOTH diagonals for	8	10	14	18	
9-1/2" WOF strip	1	1	1	1	
Sub-cut to 9-1/2" squares	2	2	2	2	
Cut 9-1/2" squares on ONE	4	4	4	4	

Clue 7: This is such a beautiful quilt. I am loving everything about it. I love that I could use four fabrics. I love the dimension the colours give. AND no matter which way you did your border snails, the end result is amazing!

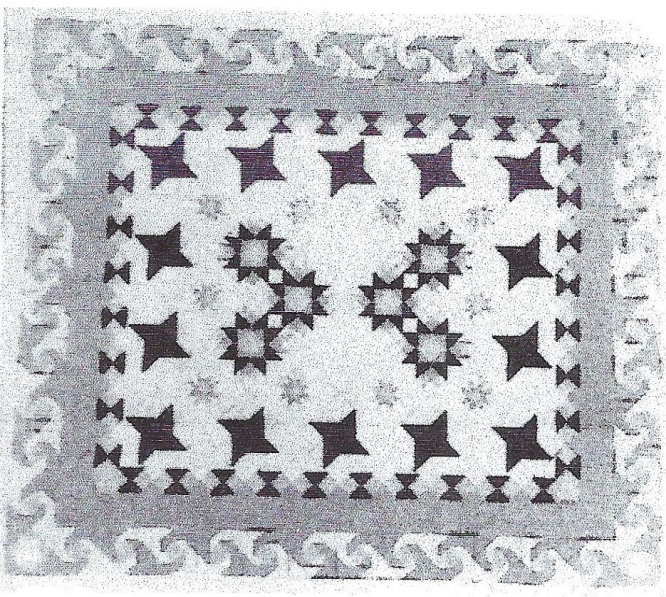
Without anymore chit chat, here is the king version layout.



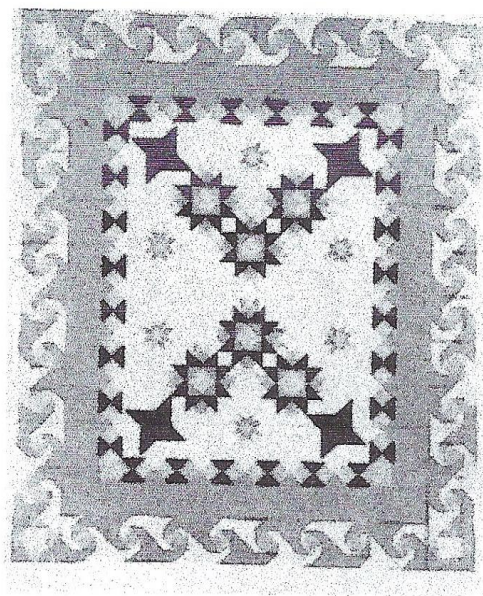
You will follow this with your snails on the top, bottom, and sides with the square in a square units from Clue 7. Your LIGHT corner always rotated inward. The maps have the border with all the snails going the same way, I have included a pic of them if you made them opposites as well.

This is a stunner no matter the size you created. Here are the maps for the other sizes:

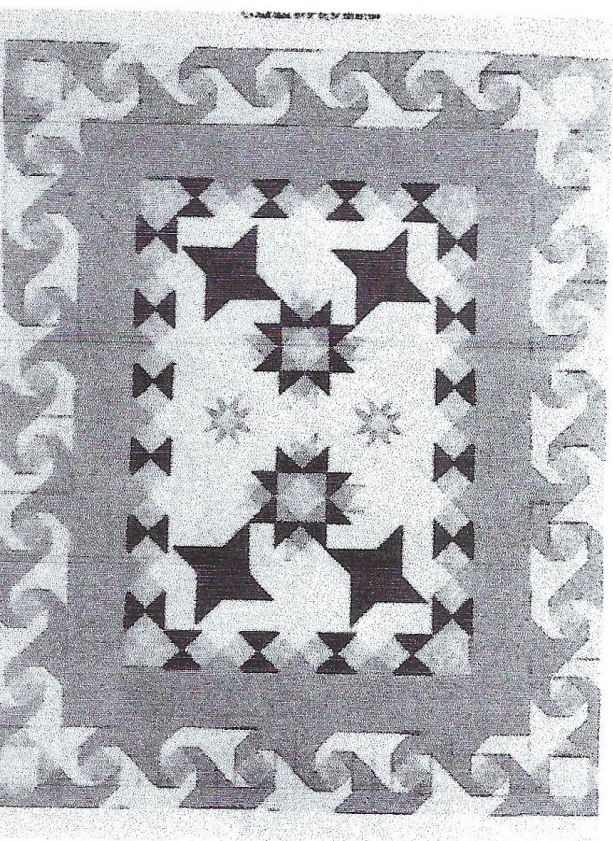
King with border:
